

Name (first, middle, last) Driver's License Number (including state)

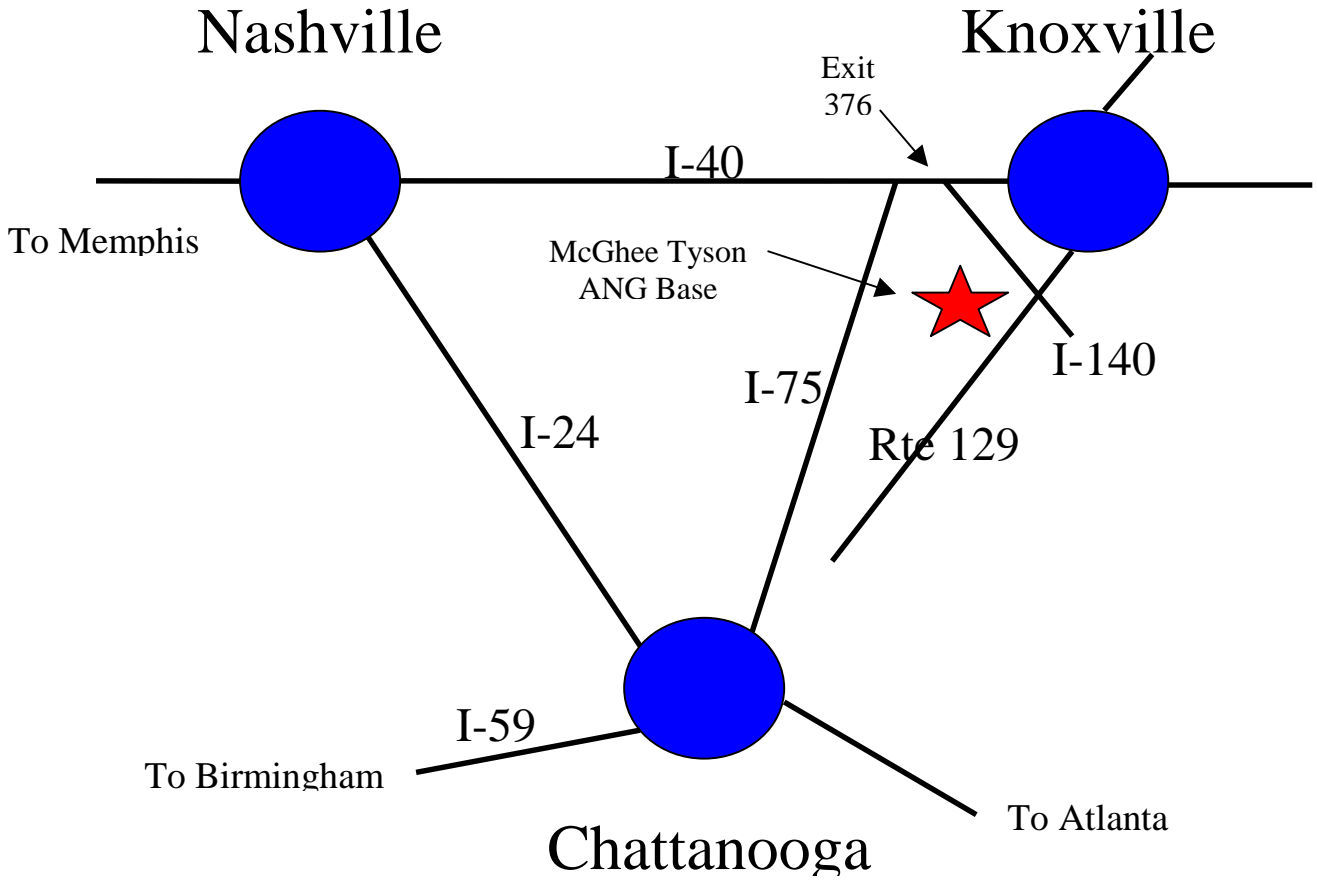

Failure to provide the information will require a military member of the Encampment to go to the Main Gate and escort the Brother to the Encampment. Please make every effort to comply with this requirement to avoid this inconvenience.

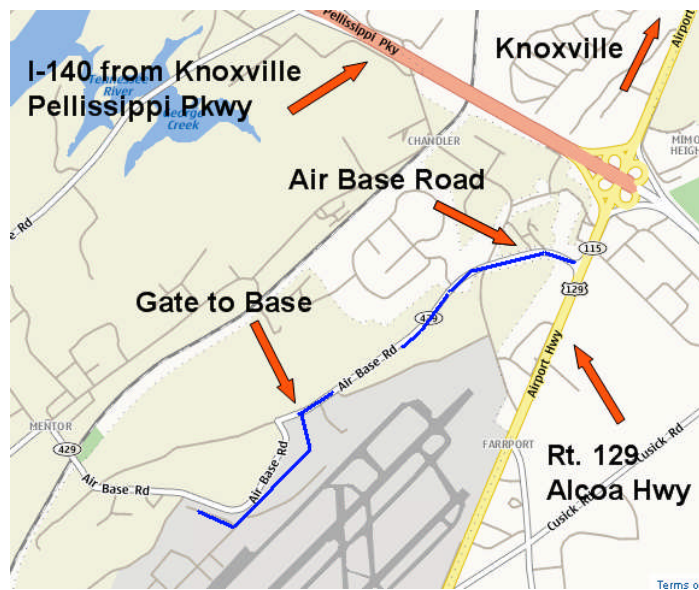
Brothers who have current base access decals do not need to provide this information.

(Map 1)

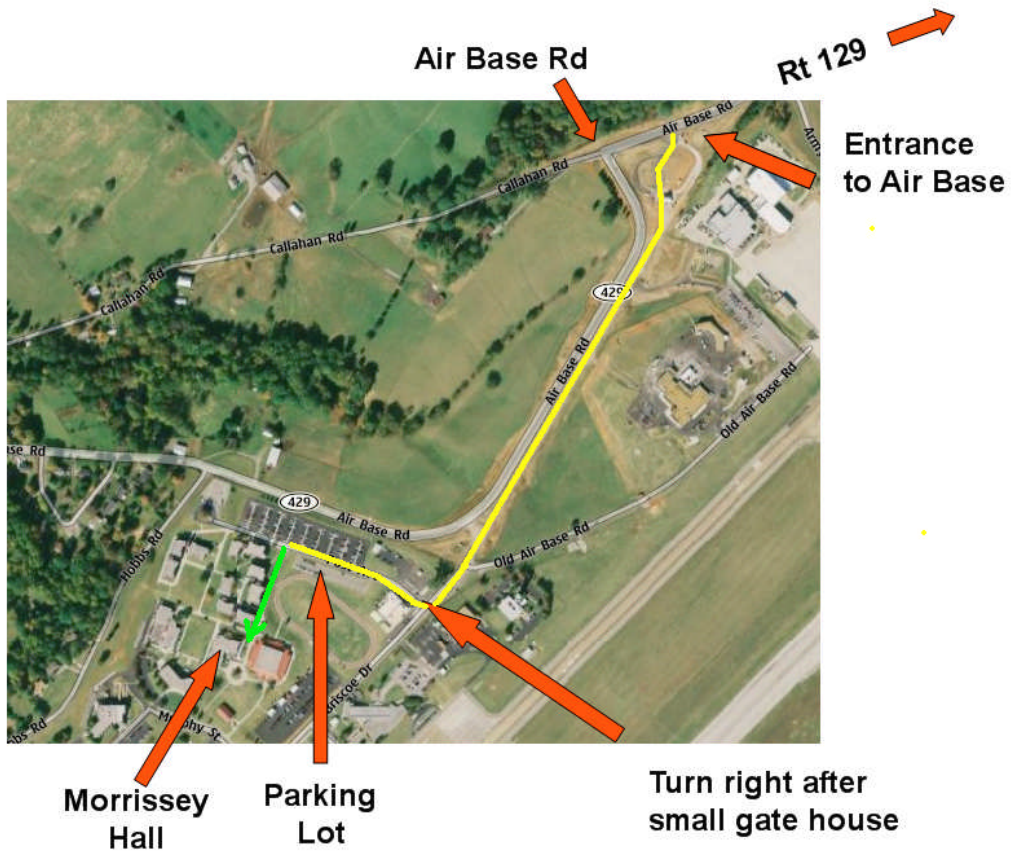


(Map 2)
